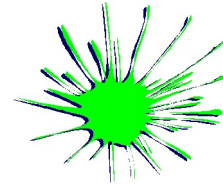

The meeting will consist of going over the rules, team organization, choosing team captains, explanation of costs, gun safety and various other issues.

Activity Fee

There will be a **\$50 Activity Charge per Youth League shooter**. The purpose of this fee is to help defray the costs of the league and banquet. (Payment arrangements can be made.)

Punch Cards

A 10 Round Punch Card is available to the Youth shooter and to be used **for practice rounds only**. The cost per card is \$45.00.

Ten Commandments of Gun Safety

- 1. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.**
- 2. Firearms should be unloaded when not actually in use.**
- 3. Don't rely on your gun's safety.**
- 4. Be sure of your target and what's beyond it.**
- 5. Use proper ammunition.**
- 6. If your gun fails to fire when the trigger is pulled, handle with care.**
- 7. ALWAYS wear eye and ear protection when shooting.**
- 8. Be sure the barrel is clear of obstructions before shooting.**
- 9. Don't alter or modify your gun and have it serviced regularly.**
- 10. RESPECT YOUR FELLOW SHOOTER.**
